Welcome to another great year at Kelly Walsh High School! I want to take this opportunity to provide you with some important information for the 2021-22 school year.

1. *More information about lunches, activities, and athletics will be provided during registration verification and freshmen orientation.*
2. *All students will receive a picture student ID and lanyard during registration verification or freshmen orientation. ID badges must be worn at all times during the school day to improve the safety of students, staff, and visitors.*
3. *Dress code - Please review the enclosed Natrona County School District Dress Code Guidelines and consider the NCSD School Board expectations as you do your back to school shopping.*

Students are encouraged to arrive at school early and in plenty of time to find a parking spot in one of the designated lots on campus. The south parking lot adjacent to 12th Street is the only parking lot designated for staff only. On-campus parking for students, visitors, and staff is available in the following areas: main parking lot (directly north of the main entrance), stadium parking lot (north of aquatics center building), and the peninsula parking lot northwest of the staff parking lot. Please be aware that the City of Casper will enforce all parking violations on city streets, and Walsh Drive and 12th Street are zoned as "No Parking" on both sides of the street. Please let your parents know that violations in these areas will be strictly enforced. Pick up and drop off areas will be available in our main parking lot.

I encourage all of you to use the parking lots on campus and to be good neighbors when you need to park in a residential area!

Please, take a few minutes to read over this **VERY IMPORTANT INFORMATION**.

REGISTRATION: The registration verification process will take place on **August 23rd for Seniors (8:00-11:00 am) and Juniors (12:30-3:30 pm) and August 24th for Sophomores (8:00-11:00 am)**. All stations must be completed in order for your registration to be complete! **Freshmen Orientation and registration verification will take place on August 20th. Freshmen should plan to attend orientation for 2 hours (see schedule below).**

SCHEDULE CHANGES: Schedule changes for Seniors are on August 11th and 12th from 8:00-11:00 am and 12:30 -3:00 pm. Juniors will be on Aug 17th from 8:00-11:30 am and 12:30-3:00 pm. Sophomores will be on Aug 18th from 8:00-11:00 am and 12:30-3:00 pm. Freshmen will be on August 19th from 8:00-11:00 am and 12:30-3:00 pm. **Please note** schedules will not be available to view on Infinite Campus until **August 2nd** so please log in and review your schedule before coming to your assigned day. Schedule changes during the school day will only be done with a teacher referral due to incorrect class placement. Students not able to come during the schedule change time will be able to make necessary changes at a later date. September 7th

will be the last day to change schedules for 1st semester. 2nd semester schedules can be changed later during the school year. If you are requesting a change, you MUST have a parent sign the schedule change form. A parent does not need to be present if the form is signed. Schedule change forms will be available on the KWHS website. NOTE: Counselors will not make changes based on lunch or friends' schedules! **Please, no emails or phone calls regarding schedule changes!** Thank you for your understanding!

The first day of school is **Wednesday, September 1st.**

ELIGIBILITY: ALL students must carry at least 2.5 credits per semester to be eligible for any activity or athletics offered at KWHS.






Freshmen Orientation and Registration Verification

Natrona County School District Dress Code Guidelines

Guideline	Yes 	No 
Any shirt or blouse should cover the back, top of shoulders, and stomach. Halter-tops, spaghetti strap shirts, low-cut tops, or tops that expose the midriff or undergarments are not permitted.		
Shorts and skirts must be no shorter than mid-thigh.		
All pants, shorts, skirts, and shorts must be worn no lower than the hips, no sagging or undergarments showing.		
Hats, caps, bandannas, sweatbands, sunglasses, chains, dog collars, and sharp objects are not to be worn in the school.		
Appropriate shoes must be worn at all times. Slippers are not allowed.		
No sleepwear is allowed.		
Clothing or personal items that are racist, sexist, promote drugs/alcohol/tobacco, or vulgar in interpretation are not allowed.		
Tights or leggings must be worn with a shirt, blouse, or tunic that is long enough to cover one's behind.
